

TDI Class Checklist

HANDGUN 1-3

If you don't have a firearm or gear, don't purchase any – use ours. Learn what is good and then go purchase it.

Handgun - that fits your hand and mission

Magazines - 3 factory magazines minimum (more is always better) plus single or double magazine holder/pouch for your belt that allows bullet forward carry

Reinforced Belt – made for guns, not fashion or dress – 1.5" min - Kydex reinforced, cross stitched leather, Wilderness 5 stitch, etc

Holster specific to your handgun with opening that retains its shape to allow re-holster with one hand – Kydex preferred - No trigger finger release types (eg: SERPA). No cross draw.

Shooting Glasses w/wrap around side protection preferred – loaners available

Hearing protection - Electronic type recommended to aid hearing instructions

Notebook and pen or pencil

Suggested personal comfort items:

Sun block

Insect repellent

Prescription meds

Ibuprofen

Rain Gear

Hat

Shirt with collar

Long pants w/belt loops

Cooler for water and electrolyte drinks

HANDGUN 4-6

Everything from HG 1-3 list PLUS:

Handheld Flashlight

Additional optional items to be considered:

IFAK (Individual First Aid Kit)
Cleaning Kit
Tools
Gloves
Knee and Elbow pads
Towel or Shemagh
Waterproof boots

Tactical Rifle Class Additions

Everything from Handgun class list PLUS

Rifle – Mil spec AR/AK style – Popular calibers .556/223 & .762-39

Sights – Irons, Red Dots, ACOGs, or Variable 1-4, 1-6, or 1-8.

Back-up irons with co-witness or lower 1/3rd recommended for Red Dots

Optic wipes or lens pen

Sling Adjustable to allow hand switching – eg; Vickers Blue Force

Shooting Mat or Rifle case drag bag that converts to a mat

Shooting Rest Bags (sand, beads) – multiple sizes - even if you have a bipod
Pack

Magazines – several 20 & 30+ with magazine pouch

Weapon mounted light not mandatory for Level 1 Tac Rifle

Desirable features covered in Class and on TDI website

Lube - Did we mention Cleaning Kit?

NOTE: Any Class 3 weapons or accessories must have ATF paperwork

Precision Rifle Class Additions

Everything from Handgun class list PLUS:

Rifle – Bring any rifle you want to learn to shoot better. Majority of shooting will

be prone, but unsupported positions will be covered as well so rifle weight

should be a consideration. If you have a heavy rifle, consider bringing a second lighter rifle in addition.

Bolt or Semiauto – Popular calibers .556/223, .308 & 6.5 Creedmoor

Long action & magnum hunting calibers have been used for hunting prep

Magnified Optic/Scope – Fixed OK but variable preferred to allow dial down

Mag range typically 2.5x to 18x - MOA or MILS – match reticle & turrets

Solid mounts - Your Optic quality is more important than rifle quality

Optic wipes or lens pen

Sling

Shooting Mat or Rifle case drag bag that converts to a mat

Shooting Rest Bags (sand, beads) – multiple sizes - even if you have a bipod

Pack

Shooting sticks

Magazines

DOPE logbook

Spotting Scope or binoculars with tripod/support desirable
